Assessment Task One Questions

Māori representation is diverse and there are structures and organisations within Māoridom that highlight this diversity. This assessment requires you to consider the diverse range of these structures and organisations that represent Māori needs and aspirations.

1. Please outline in 500 words, one iwi or one hapu and then provide the following:
 - Historical background of each and the relation of the concept of the hapu or iwi
 - The legal base or the mandate for either (where applicable)
 - The details of the activities for either. Where appropriate please provide evidence of a business plan, description of the structure and other supporting documentation you deem necessary.
 - Describe the impact of the treaty claim process and agreements on the structure and operation of both the iwi or hapu
 - Identify a range of consultative and participative requirements which government agencies and departments have made on the hapu or iwi and other associated resource issues.

2. Please identify one organisation created by government and one non-government initiated organisation and provide:
 - Historical background of each
 - The legal base or the mandate for each
 - The details of the activities for each. Where appropriate please provide evidence of a business plan, description of the structure and other supporting documentation you deem necessary.
 - An explanation of the overlap between national hapu or iwi based organisations in relation to mandate and representation.
 - Identify a range of consultative and participative requirements which government agencies and departments have made on these organisations and associated resource issues.

3. Identify one urban based Māori organisation and provide:
 - Historical background of this organisation
 - The legal base or the mandate for the organisation
 - An explanation of the overlap between national hapu or iwi based organisations in relation to mandate and representation.
 - Identify a range of consultative and participative requirements which government agencies and departments have made on the hapu or iwi and other associated resource issues.
