About the calendar

The Learning State 2010 Training Event Calendar is a series of workshops that have been tailored specifically for the needs of State sector employees.

The workshops cover a range of topics that are relevant to the State sector – such as the Treaty of Waitangi, standards of integrity and conduct, the Official Information Act, plain English writing and many more.

We have developed the Training Event Calendar in response to demand from our State sector clients, as a way of providing a value-for-money opportunity for investing in employee learning and development. State sector agencies and their employees can pick and choose from the workshop options – depending on their needs, interests and requirements.

We have made arrangements for these workshops to be delivered by training experts. Participants also have the option of being assessed at the end of the workshop if they wish to gain credits for a qualification they're working towards.

Who can take part, and what is the cost?

The calendar is open to all State sector agencies, regardless of whether they're a member of Learning State. The costs for the different workshops vary depending on the length of the workshop and the facilitator.

Where are the workshops held?
